Background

- Killeen Police department has 78 installed cameras in and around the PD headquarters and jail
- □ The current system is over 11 years old and running on outdated hardware equipment
- The Salient system used to provide live feeds to restricted areas needs updating to view attempted access to restricted area
- The Hirsch physical access system needs to be repaired and updated to be able to allow access to restricted areas

Background

- Stanley Security provided a solution with pricing through
 Sourcewell Cooperative Contract
- The new solution will provide quality images, more viewing coverage, enhance security and update both the Salient and Hirsch physical access control systems
- Recordings will be readily available to allow live monitoring,
 access to restricted areas or retrieve recordings when needed

- Do not authorize the purchase of security cameras and access control
- Authorize the anticipated expenses not to exceed \$223,987 for security cameras and access control using the Sourcewell Cooperative contract #031517-SCS

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Manager or his designee be authorized to execute the purchase of security cameras and access control from Stanley Security through the Sourcewell Contracts purchasing cooperative not to exceed \$223,987
