

REHABILITATION OF PARKING LOT PROJECT CONTRACT AWARD

Background

- Killeen-Fort Hood Regional Airport (KFHRA) readmitted into the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Military Airport Program (MAP) in 2018 for a five (5) year period
- □ The FAA has offered KFHRA a MAP grant for \$277,120
- □ This grant includes \$276,620 for construction and \$500 for advertising for the rehabilitation of the airport parking lot

 Project consists of rehabilitation of pavement surfaces, slurry seal, and restriping of all markings within the Long- and Short-Term parking lots, entrances and exits, exit lane leading to payment plaza at the KFHRA

- □ Bids were advertised March 21 and 28, 2021
- March 31, 2021, three (3) bids were received, and the results were as follows:
 - Stripe-It-Up \$130,300
 - □ Viking Construction \$276,620
 - AM Utilities and Construction \$287,700

- After review of the bid packages, Stripe-It-Up did not meet the required material specifications outline in the bid documents therefore eliminating their bid
- Staff recommends award of contract to Viking Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$276,620

Alternatives

Accept the Contract

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Approve the contract with Viking Construction, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$276,620 and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all contract documents and any and all change orders or actions within the amounts set by federal, state and local law
