

## Background

- December 2018 Street Maintenance Fee approved to assist with maintaining streets
  - Initial fee set at \$1.70, provided \$1.6 million for street maintenance
- Street condition assessment performed in 2019
  - Recommended \$4.3 million in annual street maintenance to maintain current street condition
  - Estimated \$120 million in street reconstruction
    - Winter Storm Uri added an estimated \$40 million
    - City Council approved increasing street maintenance by \$4.2 million to address emergency street repairs

## Background, continued

- July 2021 City Council received presentation on funding options to address street maintenance and reconstruction
- Following several meetings and further discussion, decision was made to move forward with \$10 monthly Street Maintenance
  Fee that is expected to generate \$9.6 million annually
  - Increase annual street maintenance by \$2.6 million to the recommended \$4.3 million
  - Provide approximately \$4.0 million annually to cash fund street reconstruction projects
  - Repay \$24.0 million bond issue to expedite street reconstruction
- Formula revised to incorporate diverted trips (stop by store on way home, changing travel path)
  - Reduced maximum commercial fee from \$5,543 to \$3,768

## **Alternatives**

- Do not amend street maintenance fees and continue using current rates
- Amend street maintenance fees

## Recommendation

City Council approve the ordinance amending Chapter 25, Streets, Sidewalks, and Miscellaneous Public Places, of the Code of Ordinances, to amend street maintenance fees
