#### **RESOLUTION**

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF THE CENTRAL TEXAS REGIONAL 9-1-1 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Chapter 772, Subchapter H, of the Texas Health and Safety Code, cited as the

Regional Emergency Communications District Act (the "Act"), provides the creation of a Regional

Emergency Communications District; and

WHEREAS, the Act applies to a state planning region established under Chapter 391 of the

Texas Local Government Code with a population of under 1.5 million, composed of counties and

municipalities that operate a 9-1-1 system solely through a regional planning commission; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires that the governing bodies of each participating county and

municipality in the region adopt a resolution approving the creation of the Regional Emergency

Communications District (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, as of May 25, 1989, the City of Killeen exclusively receives 9-1-1 system services

operated through the Council of Governments, a regional planning commission.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF KILLEEN AUTHORIZES THE CREATION OF THE CENTRAL TEXAS REGIONAL 9-1-1 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT.
