

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24, SOLID WASTE, DIVISION 6, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, TEXAS, BY AMENDING SOLID WASTE RATES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Killeen, Texas is a home-rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Killeen deems the continued operation and functionality of the City's solid waste management infrastructure to be of vital importance to the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, a solid waste rate study has determined that in order to provide continued solid waste service, it is necessary and in the best interest of the public health and safety to amend solid waste rates;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, TEXAS:

SECTION I. That Chapter 24, Division 6, of the City of Killeen Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding the following sections to read as follows:

Sec. 24-116. Commercial rates.

- (a) Once per week collection using a 96-gallon container: ~~\$21.30~~ \$23.00 per month.
- (b) ~~Once per week collection using a 300-gallon container: \$57.10 per month.~~
- (c) Dumpster container rates are based on size of container and frequency of weekly collection.

~~Rates established in this division 6 shall be adjusted annually and become effective on October 1 of each successive year by the same percentage as the Consumer Price Index (CPI) (Dallas/Fort Worth Region for all urban consumers, less energy) as published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, during the preceding twelve (12) month period as measured from July of the previous year through June of the then-current year.~~

SECTION II. That all ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III. That should any section or part of any section, paragraph or clause of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, it shall not invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section or sections or part of a section or paragraph of this ordinance.

SECTION IV. That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Killeen, Texas, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION V. That this ordinance shall be effective on October 1, 2021.
