PURCHASE OF IRRIGATION CONTROL PANELS

Background and Findings

- Irrigation control panels control how water is irrigated throughout the entire golf course property
- Current irrigation control panels are (30) years old
 - USGA standard recommendation for replacing these panels is between 10-15 years
- Project was funded during FY 2021, before project could start the system/panels were struck by lightning on May 23, 2021
 - Reported the damage through TML, their assessment of the damage was completed and TML will cover \$42,671

Background and Findings

- One-time cost of the project is \$85,891.20, with TML covering \$42,671 for the damage caused by lightning. The City's financial impact will be \$43,220.20
- New panels will give the golf course a much more efficient system. Few areas this system will help:
 - Water savings
 - Staff time spent of programming (Manual watering)
 - Program selection from built in mapping system (Ease of map guide)
 - Electrical savings (nonpeak times scale, alert shutdowns)

Alternative to Consider

- Option 1– Decline to purchase/replacement of the irrigation panels.
 - This option will leave the course playability in serious jeopardy as our ability to water the course would be increasingly difficult
- Option 2 Approve the purchase of the golf course irrigation panels with Professional Turf Products, L.P.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the purchase with Professional Turf Products, L.P. as submitted for a total not to exceed \$85,891.20 in FY 2021 and that the City Manager or designee be authorized to execute any change orders as permitted by state and local law.
