BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

On May 6, 2024, two (2) bids were received for Stonetree Golf Club Bunker renovations.

This project was to include survey and staking, clearing, grading, and removal of the old bunker, sand, the construction of the bunkers and grassing.

Greenscapes Six, LLC.	\$815,389.75

We have \$173,340 budgeted in our CIP/Projects/Construction account, unfortunately this is not sufficient to cover the cost of the lowest bid.
