BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On April 27, 2016, the City of Killeen issued an RFQ for qualified executive search firms to help with recruiting for a City Manager. Submittals were due May 25, 2016, and Strategic Government Resources (SGR) provided the best value. As part of the interview process, SGR recommends that the City Council create and utilize a Citizens' Advisory Committee to assist in the selection of the new City Manager.
